The plan must include a risk analysis, Hepatitis B vaccinations, follow-up procedures, an evaluation of safer sharps and training. CDS and the Chicago Medical Society once again jointly offer OSHA Training Updates to members and their staffs.

- Volunteer at one of the many other places that serve those without access to dental care and need your talents. Visit on.cds.org/help to get started.



# How about simply asking?

MAJOR CONCERN WITHIN ORGANIZED DENTISTRY, AND CERTAINLY FOR MANY ORGANIZATIONS, IS DECLINING MEMBERSHIP.

The many advances in technology have reshaped our lives. Yet, the more things change, the more they stay the same. The best way to get young dentists to join organized dentistry is to simply ask them to join.

The world really has changed over the last decade or two. Just watch a movie from the 1990s for an interesting flashback. Technology has changed the world and the way we look at things. Coming home to check messages on the answering machine seems a lifetime ago. Newspapers have given way to internet news. Even faxes are passé.

As times have changed, people have changed. The Millennials (born 1981-2000) are very different from Generation X (born 1965-1980) and even more different than the Baby Boomers (born 1946-1964). These differences have created a wider generation gap than ever before. Boomers live to work while Millennials and Gen Xers work to live. Boomers saw education as a birthright; Gen Xers saw it as a way to get there, and Millennials see education as an incredible expense. Boomers see work as a career; Gen Xers see it as a difficult challenge, and Millennials see it as a means to an end. These attitude changes are just a few of the changes that have widened the generation gap. Outside of styles, Boomers had much more in common with their parents (called the Traditionalist generation, born 1900-1945) than they ever will have with Millennials or Gen Xers. With all the changes that have occurred in the world, we must understand younger people if we are ever to relate to them.

In dental school, I joined organized dentistry because I thought it was the

right thing to do. Yes, you received the magazines and life insurance, but mostly you felt proud to share a membership with dentists. As a young man in dental school, I felt that by being a member of the American Student Dental Association, I was joining the legion of dentistry. I really didn't care about magazines because I had enough to read in school. Insurance? Who needs insurance when you're in your 20s?

Membership in ASDA was an easy,

albeit cheap way to join the club.

When my classmates and I graduated school, we were faced with the decision to pay and join organized dentistry. Some folks who did not have a mentor didn't join. Unlike them, I was lucky

enough to be an associate in a couple of practices with very active senior dentists. They asked me to come to meetings with them and encouraged me to be a part of organized dentistry. They paid for my dinner meetings and even rented a tuxedo for me for a formal dinner. Naturally, they wanted me to join. And I did join organized dentistry because they asked me to join; I wanted to be a part of this group, which I respected so much. I joined organized dentistry because they asked me and expected me to join.

Dental students today are driven and committed individuals who not only care about their future but the future of their profession. They graduate with unbelievable debt and many are forced into practicing in situations that they never envisioned, just to make ends meet. As they find their way in their

> profession and new career, it is up to the more "seasoned" practitioners to mentor them. We need to patiently show our new colleagues understanding and respect. Then in turn, they will understand and respect the profession.

As changes occur in life and in our profession, we need to keep in mind that the more things change, the more they stay the same.

Despite our differences, we still all need to belong. Despite different generations' perceptions among our colleagues, our profession must work together to stay strong.

So ask a young dentist to come to a





meeting. If that young person can't go that night to that meeting, ask them again. Tell them to come as your guest. Show our young colleagues how much they need organized dentistry and that organized dentistry wants them.

It is important to remember that all young dentists and dental students have all gone to the dentist before they went to dental school. Chances are they had a deep respect for their family dentist. These good feelings are probably one of the reasons that they were attracted to the profession. It is important to nurture, develop and maintain a relationship with young dentists and potential dental students.

Don't be intimidated by change and use it as an excuse to turn your back on



And now dogs might be finding their way into the dental profession.

The University of Michigan School of Dentistry this year called on therapy dogs to help students facing the stress of final exams and graduation. And at least one dental office in suburban Chicago has a dog visit on a regular basis.

"The act of petting a dog can lower

your blood pressure and increase your endorphins, so there is a positive physical component to a visit," according to Lynne Ryan, a dental hygienist at Pediatric Dentistry of Northbrook, who is also a volunteer handler with Lutheran Church Charities' Comfort Dog Min-

Ms. Ryan, who has worked with CDS member dentist Thomas Resnik at the dental office for about 24 years, knew JoJo did well at school visits, so she had

the idea about a year ago to bring her into the office.

JoJo now comes in once a month. Patients schedule appointments when JoJo is available and the practice makes sure there are no allergy issues or fear of dogs. The rooms also get a thorough cleaning after each visit.

"Everything has been positive," Ms. Ryan said of the visits.

Ms. Ryan said it has been mostly new patients who seek JoJo's attention.







"It's a comfort just having her in the room," Ms. Ryan said of JoJo's work. But some patients want the dog to sit on their lap or be in contact with them.

And sometimes, it is not the patient who needs the reassuring, Ms. Ryan noted.

The dog can size up a situation amazingly well, she said. For instance, a child with autism came into the office one time while JoJo was on duty.

Ms. Ryan said JoJo knew who in the room really needed comforting the most and went right to the child's mother, and sat with her head in the mom's lap during the entire visit.

"She has a sixth sense about who needs her," Ms. Ryan said.

Erin Fesnak of Schaumburg schedules JoJo for her 11-year-old daughter, Ava Perez. Ava has anxiety about medical procedures after having surgery last year and suffering from posttraumatic stress disorder, Ms. Fesnak said.

"The dog calmed her down tremendously," she said.

The first visit was just a consultation, when Ava was able to meet JoJo and the dental office could evaluate if the interaction was positive.

On her next visit, the dog helped calm Ava enough for her to get X-rays.

"For her to come in and get the Xrays was amazing," Ms. Fesnak said.

Since then Ava has not had a panic attack about going to the dentist.

JoJo, like all of the Lutheran Ministry's dogs, is a golden retriever.

But Billie Smith, who heads the Alliance of Therapy Dogs based in Wyoming, said that any breed could serve as a therapy dog.

"We have 1-pound Chihuahuas and 280-pound mastiffs who work as service dogs," Ms. Smith said.

The only restriction is that the dog not be part wolf or covote.

There are about 17,000 therapy dogs registered through the volunteer organization, with about 15,000 handlers, Ms. Smith explained.

There is no specialized training, but the organization does have a registration

> process with a number of testers who certify that the dogs and the handlers are able to do the work.

The certification includes an obedience test that shows the dog can be under control with a 4-foot leash, evidence that the dog has good manners and doesn't jump or try to lick people, and that the animal is not aggressive toward other dogs.

"We look at the temperament of the dogs," Ms. Smith said. "We focus on the relationship between the dog and the handler."

The registry extends into the United States, Puerto Rico and Canada, Ms. Smith said.

Ms. Ryan said that interest in using a therapy dog spiked after numerous media outlets ran stories about JoJo.

"Dentists from all over the country have been calling up and asking, 'can we order a JoJo?" Ms. Ryan said.

However, she doesn't know of any other comfort dogs through Lutheran Charities being used in dental offices and no Chicago area certification handlers from the Alliance of Therapy Dogs reported going to dental offices.

Ms. Smith said using a dog at a dental office sounds like a good idea, but that dentists should not just bring in their own pet for an afternoon.

The dog's needs, such as bathroom breaks and quiet time, have to be considered as well.

Plus, therapy dogs have experience that a regular pet would not have.

"Our dogs are all socialized in a good number of situations," Ms. Smith said. "So, for instance, the use of a dental drill wouldn't bother them at all."

# Chicago takes smokeless tobacco out of the park

IN MARCH, CHICAGO AND NEW YORK CITY JOINED SAN FRAN-CISCO. BOSTON AND LOS ANGELES IN ENACTING A BAN ON SMOKELESS TOBACCO in the cities' major league ballparks as well as other high school, college and amateur sports facilities. Negotiations are on in other major cities as well.

"It's a good public health victory," observed Gerald Ciebien, vice chair of the Chicago Dental Society's Government Affairs and Access Advocacy Committee.

The "Knock Tobacco Out of the Park" campaign looks to make smokeless tobacco, known as chew, snuff or dip, less appealing to young people by setting higher age restrictions for purchase and outright bans on use. Organizations like the Campaign for Smoke-Free Kids and Tobacco Free Baseball have joined forces with CDS, the American Dental Association, Oral Health Foundation, Respiratory Health Association, the American Medical Asso-

ciation and others to press for legislation to snuff out tobacco use.

It was once commonplace to see athletes – either live at the ballpark or on television – using "chew" and spitting, and many young boys picked up smokeless tobacco to be like their heroes on the field.

Because professional baseball players are still powerful role models for young people, Dr. Ciebien said, an outright ban on its use will help dampen the allure of what is a dangerous, addictive habit.

"We want (athletes) to set the right example," Dr. Ciebien said. The goal is, he said, that with higher age purchase

restrictions as well as less visibility of the use of "chew" among ballplayers, young people will be less likely to pick up the habit.

According to a researcher at the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), tobacco use among young, high school students is a big concern because most adult tobacco users first try tobacco before the age of 18. "The younger people are when they start using tobacco, the more likely they are to become addicted, and the more heavily addicted they can become," said the CDC's Brian King.

But tobacco companies have fought back, investing heavily in smokeless tobacco products with ad campaigns surpassing \$435 million in 2014. Though marketed through print advertising and athlete testimonials as "safer" alternatives to cigarette and cigar smoking, these products are just as dangerous. Highly

addictive nicotine from smokeless tobacco is absorbed three to four times faster in the tissue, and its placement along the gum causes lesions in the mouth, tooth decay and can lead to oral, pancreatic and esophageal cancers.

One of the most highprofile casualties was Hallof-Famer Tony Gywnn, who died in 2014 at age 54 from salivary gland oral cancer, which Mr. Gwynn blamed on his use of smokeless tobacco. His family is suing a major tobacco company and its subsidiary that sells smokeless tobacco prod-

ucts. Former Major League pitcher Curt Schilling also was treated for oral cancer that he attributes to his 30-year use of smokeless tobacco.

Though the number of cigarette smokers continues to fall, the use of smokeless tobacco has held steady since 1999. Efforts to deter people, especially impressionable young people, from taking up the habit are crucial to maintain health long-term. Tobacco use, Dr. Ciebien said, represents "the single largest preventable source of oral cancer."

The bans in Chicago and New York City are major successes in getting smokeless tobacco out of baseball parks, and more work remains to be done. The California Legislature passed a law that

> will expand the ban at three more major league stadiums in 2017, and legislators in Toronto and Washington, DC, are considering similar laws. Their action would bring the total to 10 ballparks out of 30 with smokeless tobacco bans in effect next year.

> Additionally, attention may now shift to contract negotiations with Major League Baseball. Oddly, while smokeless tobacco is banned in the minor leagues, the contract with major league players only prohibits players from using such products during television interviews and bans players from carrying tins in their uniform pockets. The players' union would not agree to a total ban in the 2011 contract.

In Illinois. Dr. Ciebien said he is

looking ahead to action on state Senate Bill 3011, which would raise the age statewide to 21 from 18 for tobacco possession and purchases, including electronic cigarettes. Sponsored by State

Sen. John Mulroe (D-10th) of Chicago and passed by the Senate, the bill is now in the House awaiting action.

Strong relationships built with city, state and national elected officials by CDS and ADA helped pave the way for quick action on the legislation, Dr. Ciebien said. Sen. Richard Durbin (D-IL)

was an early supporter, and Chicago Ald. Edward Burke (D-14th) fasttracked the measure through his Finance Committee. Chicago Mayor Rahm Emanuel added provisions raising the smoking age to 21, raising taxes on cigars and other tobacco products and other restrictions aimed at discouraging tobacco use. The legislation was approved March 16.

Smokeless tobacco "is a very powerful addiction." Dr. Ciebien said. "Smokeless does not mean harmless."

Where can I turn to for career advice?

HETHER OR NOT YOU WORK IN A TRADITIONAL OFFICE ENVIRONMENT, EVERY WORKDAY ENDS THE SAME: FILLED WITH FAR MORE QUESTIONS THAN ANSWERS.

How can I improve in this area of my career? My colleagues were all talking about some new regulation at lunch; what's that all about?

And how quickly do I need to act on the other thing?

We're all looking for answers quickly (because that bedside alarm is going to wake us for another work day soon enough), but we're also leery of answers that come too quickly and from so-called experts we find online but don't know anything about. These are our careers, after all, and they should be handled with care.

Many members of organized dentistry start their searches for actionable answers at the American Dental Association's Center for Professional Success (CPS). This online tool is divided into three sections: practice management research and advice, continuing education opportunities and lifestyle articles to keep your body healthy and your life in balance. The site was launched in 2013 and is managed by the ADA Council on Dental Practice; it currently ranks among the ADA's top member benefits.

"We intend for our users to find the answers they are looking for quickly, 24 hours a day, in one place that is updated frequently and responsive to the changing profession," explained Betsy Shapiro, CPS senior manager. "For some of our users, CPS is a perfectly adequate source of information. For others, they are interested in more solid backing and go on to seek out practice consultants. Our site is not intended to replace practice consultants, but to teach users about the questions they need to be asking."

The site's content comes from a variety of sources. The ADA staff provides information about regulatory changes and legal

issues, including HIPAA, OSHA and Medicare. Professional consultants are called on to discuss other areas of business management. And a few select corporations have provided technical information for CPS, such as the loan payment and overhead calculators supplied by Wells Fargo & Co.

The site also provides many of the ADA's research and White Papers, in various forms, Dr. Shapiro said. Alongside the fulllength documents, staff writers extract from them FAQs and check lists for members who are interested in consuming the same information in shorter forms.





For the best user experience dentists should come to the site with a search term in mind – specific information they are seeking. The hottest topics right now are regulatory issues.

"Health care will of course come up after the presidential election, and so right now there are several new regulations that different groups are trying to push through before November," Dr. Shapiro said. "At CPS we don't work in advocacy, but we do report on the impact of these changes as final rulings are made."

Another popular search right now is for Medicare enrollment information. The government has pushed back the optin/out deadline for a fourth time and questions remain among ADA members across the country.

"In the more traditional practice management areas, we field a lot of questions about closing down a practice in the case of a retirement - what to do about the patients and the staff - and about opening a new practice from members early in their careers. We have a checklist for them," Dr. Shapiro said.

"And we've had an explosion of dentists who prefer to work as employees rather than be practice owners, so for them there are plenty of resources on employment contracts and developing patient relationships."

A redesigned, mobile-enabled site is slated to launch this summer. Members will still have to sign in to access content.

# Dispelling five dento-legal myths

FTEN CONTACTED BY DENTISTS WHO HAVE LEGAL QUESTIONS, I keep seeing the persistence of certain dento-legal myths. So let's dispel five common myths.

**MYTH NO. 1:** A REFUND IS AN ADMISSION OF GUILT Illinois law is clear: Refunding a patient is not a sign of guilt and cannot be used as a sword against the dentist should the case proceed to a lawsuit. Moreover, it is not a "failure" on the dentist's part to refund money. As in certain circumstances, it may be a wise business decision that averts years of litigation.

**MYTH NO. 2:** CONSENT FORMS DON'T HOLD UP IN COURT When properly presented to a patient, a written consent form is a powerful defensive tool during litigation, especially during a trial. Keep in mind that obtaining a patient's informed consent is not merely handing a piece of paper with risks to sign, but, rather, it is a verbal process memorialized by the written consent form.

And while merely having a patient sign a consent form is not insulation against liability, the consent form shows the defendant dentist is thorough and the patient knew the risks before undertaking the procedure.

# MYTH NO. 3: IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO HAVE AN ATTORNEY WHEN TALKING WITH REGULATORS

A greater percentage of patients these days are filing complaints with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation (IDFPR), ranging from serious allegations of misconduct, such as filing false insurance forms, to more mundane complaints, such as a dentist's refusal to provide copies of a patient's records.

Regardless of the allegation, the dental professional should always consult with an attorney who has experience with IDFPR matters, as even minor cases can mushroom into more serious problems without legal guidance.

It's hard to "un-ring the bell" when a dentist makes damaging statements to an IDFPR investigator such as, "It's not my job to make sure every dental insurance form submitted by my staff is accurate."

# MYTH NO. 4: AS LONG AS I DOCUMENT A PATIENT'S REFUSAL FOR X-RAYS, I CAN'T BE SUED

While it is important to document a patient's refusal to undergo a dental procedure or diagnostic test, such as an X-ray, merely documenting such a refusal may not be enough to avoid liability.

In regards to X-rays, a dentist must explain why radiographs are a crucial part of the diagnostic process to uncover decay or periodontal disease. To not do so, a dentist is shirking his responsibility as a health care educator and may expose himself to a malpractice claim.

# MYTH NO. 5: HIRING AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR INSULATES MY DENTAL PRACTICE FROM LIABILITY


A dental practice may designate a dentist as an independent contractor dentist under the assumption that the practice owner is insulating himself from liability should the independent contractor commit malpractice. However, such a notion is false.

In Illinois, a dental practice may be vicariously liable for alleged negligent acts by any dentist working under the roof of the practice under the legal theory of "apparent agency." That means unless a patient is advised of the professional status of the independent contractor dentist (i.e. informed that Dr. Smith is an independent contractor working at Dr. Jones' dental practice), then it is reasonable for the patient to assume that Dr. Smith is an employee of the practice.

By knowing fact from myth, you will be in a better position to avoid legal liability so you can sleep better at night. ■

# The kids are all right

N JUNE 2015, I ATTENDED THE BRIDGING CEREMONY AT MIDWESTERN UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF DENTAL MEDI-CINE - ILLINOIS. This event celebrates the transition for second-year dental students from pre-clinical studies to the "real world" of the dental clinic.


> What a great way to begin your professional career, supporting your professional organization while aiding those most in need. We can all learn from the Academic Chapter's efforts.



## Elisa Ochoa creates a practice to address the specific needs of Pilsen by Joanna Brown

HEN IT CAME TIME TO PLAN HER FUTURE, ELISA OCHOA REFLECTED ON HER ROOTS. She thought back to her childhood and the times she was called on to translate the English spoken by health care providers, bankers and other professionals for her immigrant parents. Dr. Ochoa's parents emigrated from Mexico in the 1960s with limited knowledge of English, and it was clear to Dr. Ochoa early on that their inability to communicate grossly affected their knowledge base.

> "As I got older, I knew that I wanted to work more hands-on in these situations to make it easier for families like mine to get what they need," she said.

Today, Dr. Ochoa is readying her new dental office in Chicago's Pilsen neighborhood with special features tailored for her Latino patient base. Her Mexican heritage, clinical training and experience living in Pilsen will improve her adopted community.

"At school they taught us to practice where we wanted to live, and this is a community I vibed with," said Dr. Ochoa, a 2011 graduate of the University of Illinois at Chicago College of Dentistry. "I'd never lived here growing up, but I had a lot of family in the area and I knew that there were opportunities and a really lively culture."

She learned quickly that the neighborhood needs her service, too. While she found many resources for patients with Public Aid, she identified far fewer options for the working poor and lower middle class families.

So she designed a business model to





help them. When Pilsen Smiles opens later this summer, patients may pay an annual fee for a membership in her practice; this will include two cleanings, X-rays and dental exams, as well as discounts on other services and access to a

She'll work evenings and early mornings, too, to accommodate the schedules of her working patients.

payment plan.

"I definitely won't be working bankers' hours," she said, "and the payment plan will

enable patients to get their needs met in a timely fashion.

"We're not going to be just a dental office. I want to employ people from the neighborhood and improve it in any way we can. We don't know how little or how much people know about their health, but sometimes it just takes

someone they can trust to figure it out."

Toward that end, Dr. Ochoa has been working with Pilsen community leaders and not-for-profit organizations to learn more about the community's

> oral health while she completes construction on her new office space. The schedule is as rewarding as it is exhausting, but the experience is making her a better dentist and businesswoman, she said. She encouraged other young dentists to pursue a similar path.

"Figure out what motivates you, and

touch back on that," Dr. Ochoa said. "Look within yourself and see what got you here in the first place. That something is still within you, so be humble about where you came from.

"Get involved with your community; get to know the other business owners, get to know the aldermen and get introductions to other people and the not-for-profits. I walked door-to-door and lived in the community to learn what they go through and

"Take a step back to work on yourself and realize what drives you. That should be enough to keep you moving and tackle what's on your plate." ■

# Hanging out with Jeri Coffey

ERI COFFEY HAS A NUMBER OF HOBBIES THAT HELP HER UNWIND AFTER A TOUGH DAY WORKING IN THE OPERATORY. One of the Riverside dentist's favorite past times is flying. But her version of flying doesn't involve airplanes, kites or even hot air balloons.

Her version involves leotards and trapeze bars and floating through the air with the greatest of ease about two stories above ground.

The 1981 graduate from Loyola University School of Dentistry said her introduction to the activity came when her family planned a vacation to a Club Med location that offered trapeze as an activity. She said she thought it would be a treat for her youngest son, now an adult, who was into gymnastics.

But her son balked at the opportuni-

ty and she figured his fear of heights, which she shares, had gotten the better of him.

She did gymnastics as a kid so she said she would show him the way.

"Unfortunately my fear of heights kicked in big time and by the time I climbed the ladder and got to the platform I was paralyzed by fear and crying," Dr. Coffey said. "It was terrible."

She spent about 20 minutes on the platform shaking and weeping with trepidation and couldn't force herself to go back down the ladder, even though she was wearing a safety belt.

"I was like, 'you're going to have to find a way to get a bathroom up here because I am not leaving this platform," she said looking back at the incident.

The instructors talked her into grabbing the bar, buckled her knees from behind her and guided her through completing a trick called a knee hang.

"Once I couldn't see anything I was able to get up and do the trick," she said

After Dr. Coffey dropped to the net, and was safely back on terra firma, she tried to get her son to do it.

Her ploy failed, but she did succeed in discovering a new hobby for herself.

"As it turned out he had zero interest in it, but I loved it," she said. Her fear of heights was still an issue. So she eventually went through hypnosis, which helped her conquer the fear and let her





enjoy the sport.

"I do the big tricks like in the real circus so I don't even take off from the platform," she explained. "I take off from a real thin bar 5 feet above that, where I'm hanging on the top of the trapeze, so, clearly hypnosis works."

Every six months after the initial trip Dr. Coffey would go to a Club Med resort that offered trapeze just so she could keep up on the sport. Eventually she learned that a trapeze school had opened up in Chicago and she has been going there ever since.

"What I love about it is that you are so in the moment the whole entire time you are doing it, no matter what your prob-

lems are there is nothing else you can think of than doing trapeze," she said.

Her biggest trick is a double backflip that entails catching another performer and includes 27 movements in seven seconds that "have to be executed with such precision that it is unbelievable," she said.

A shoulder injury has sidelined her from doing trapeze, but she plans on getting back up and flying in late summer.

"I have injured myself," the 61-yearold said. "I had two torn ligaments in my knee, I split my head on the bar, but you know what, you fly with the big dogs and stuff is going to happen to you."

Being grounded hasn't stopped the LaGrange resident from enjoying herself. Singing and dancing are her two other pursuits.

Dr. Coffey said she started taking ballroom dance lessons because "trapeze makes your upper body really, really strong but you're not really doing anything with your legs."

Her husband wasn't interested in dancing, so she partners with someone

at the studio.

"I do it just as a workout, and it is an astoundingly hard workout, I mean you're breathless at the end of it and you're sweating, it's really good," she said.

There are other benefits, she added, noting that dance is also her "anti-Alzheimer's program."

"When you do work or movement that involves math, that helps create new brain pathways so when you have to memorize steps like that it's a mathematical sort of thing," she explained. "So, that's another reason why I started doing it."

Dr. Coffey also sings as a hobby, doing karaoke as well as participating in a choir.

"I will sing about two-and-a-half hours a day, and I sing often with my patients, where if I'm not singing they'll say 'what's wrong why aren't you singing," she said.

She said she was a premed student when a summer job at a dental office led her to change her career path to den-

were the two things that I never wanted to be, but literally the first day that I worked there I went

> home and said to my mom, 'that's it, I want to be a dentist, this is it'," she said.

Her life and work philosophies revolve around challenges and having fun.

"I ask my patients I have not seen in six months 'what's new, what's fun. And everyone's like, 'well nothing's new and nothing's really fun," she said. "Well, we're at an age when we have to have some fun because

considers dentistry to be a "fun" job with exciting, new and innovative aspects, and that it can be challenging.

"That's what I say to kids, 'here's what's good about being a dentist: you're a psychologist because no one wants to come to you and everyone is afraid, you are an artist because you have to figure out what will make this person look the most attractive, and you're a tool and die maker because everything you do has to be done with such precision work."

And those three things make the job interesting, she said.

But it is also hard work, she concedes.

"This is a stressful job, emotionally, mentally and physically, and you need to have fun," she said. "Fun is what reenergizes you to come back here and be the best dentist that you can be. So I think everybody should look for fun, and if they don't have that in their life, they have to look around and find it."





# Things ain't as bad as you think

YOU'VE BEEN READING THE BUSINESS SECTION OF YOUR FAVORITE NEWSPAPER, YOU MAY BE AWARE OF THE RUSH OF PHYSICIANS tripping over themselves to sell their practices to hospitals and other medical entities. Self-appointed "futurists" intone, "As medicine goes, so goes dentistry." Maybe not.

The rapid rise of large multi-establishment corporate dental practices has caused hand-wringing among many in the profession who fear that they and their practices will be swallowed up by these entities. There is no doubt that the practice of dentistry is undergoing consolidation and transformation, mirroring – to a limited extent – the consolidation in the medical profession.



On April 15, the American Dental Association Health Policy Institute released a research brief, Considering Large Group Dental Practices as a Vehicle for Consolidation in Dentistry, authored by Albert Guay, chief policy advisor emeritus, and Thomas Wall, ADA manager of statistical research, that shows the growth of large practices (those with at least 20 employees) increased their market share, while those with fewer than five employees saw their market share decline.

It all sounds ominous for traditional practices. But is it?

There is a chink appearing in the armor of the mega-practices that share similarities with a Ponzi scheme that crumbles under its

own weight. During the Great Recession of 2007 through 2009, the number of firms continued to grow. However, the period from 2010 to 2012 saw a decrease in the number of large group

practices. The authors of the survey said this phenomenon might be due to difficulty finding new markets and the potential emergence of diseconomies of scale as they grow.

What interested me most were the conclusions drawn by Dr. Guay and Mr. Wall from their research. They said dentistry has unique aspects that preclude the kind of consolidations occurring in medicine. The principal reason is that small dental offices usually correlate with the location of dental patients, facilitating strong dentist-patient relationships. Dentistry is the foster child in the Affordable Care Act and government has little incentive to regulate the dental care industry through consolidation.

No doubt mega-practices have economic advantages due to economies of scale. They can buy technology and hire specialized personnel. They can employ recent dental graduates by offering an immediate paycheck and perks a small practice cannot.

However, large practices experience higher overhead such as high rents, real estate taxes, employee and advertising costs. They have a high turnover rate of new dentists, who seek their own practice as soon as it's economically feasible. The sheer size of mega-practices works against them. When they reach a critical mass of patients, they must find ways to keep the turnstiles continually rotating.

Today's traditional-practice dentists do have some advantages. They often are a part of the community and many times are the neighbors of their patients. They often grew up and went to the schools in the area in which they practice; they're local folks.

Traditional-practice dentists are trusted in their communities and frequently serve as leaders on school boards, not-for-profit service organizations and religious institutions.

Yes, I know that some of these endeavors are common to those who practice in mega-practices, too. But I suspect staff turnover at mega-practices precludes the forming of lasting patient-doctor relationships, which is inherent to the traditional practice.

You see, I think that things ain't as bad as they seem. The rumor of the death of traditional dental practice is greatly exaggerated.
