



VOX POP Comments from our readers

Resolution 7 addresses expanded functions of dental assistants

There was a typographical error in the December 2016 Final Impressions column written by Editor Walter Lamacki.

The editorial. "G.V. Black was Right," was about changes in dental auxiliary roles. Normally, this would not warrant a response, but this particular subject matter is a nationwide "hot topic," so clarification is needed.

The column reports that Illinois State Dental Society House of Delegates' Resolution 7 was based on Council on Dental Accreditation standards for dental therapists: this is incorrect. Resolution 7



actually refers to Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) standards for dental assistants, specifically standard 2-10, which addresses expand-

ed functions for dental assis-

Resolution 7 allows for the Illinois State Dental Society Board of Trustees to have a template of expanded functions that has been approved by the House of Delegates. That template follows an established list used by educational programs for their curricula to the extent state law allows. Illinois already allowed eight of the 12 items in standard 2-10. The additional items would bring us in line with many other states which allow expanded functions by dental auxiliaries.

The most important thing to remember is that the Illinois Dental Practice Act requires that tasks performed by dental assistants are under the direct supervision of the dentist. A dental hygienist may perform any task that a dental assistant is allowed to do (with additional training) and is also under the direct supervision of the dentist.

The ISDS officers and trustees are committed to developing solutions to access to care issues that comport

with the values of our members. Passage of Resolution 7 allows for the ISDS Board of Trustees and Governmental Affairs Committee to do their work within a framework that has been vetted through the House of Delegates. These additional tools will make us more effective against the outside forces that would like to alter the Illinois Dental Practice Act. ISDS can send a clear message that dental therapy is not a solution for Illinois.

CDS dentist raises money for special needs patient

A CHICAGO DENTAL SOCIETY MEMBER IS SPEARHEAD-ING AN EFFORT TO RAISE FUNDS TO HELP A CHICAGO AREA 10-YEAR-OLD BOY WITH CEREBRAL PALSY get needed dental care that requires expensive anesthesia.

Dr. Jeffrey Cantor, along with colleague John Mrozek, are trying to raise money to help Alex K., who has cerebral palsy and a severe seizure disorder and has extensive tooth decay due to his need to take a syrup medication that contains sugar three times a day.

The treatment requires general anesthesia. The boy's mother, who is his sole caregiver, does not have the financial ability to pay for the procedure and also needs extensive dental care. She also has other health problems and faces foreclosure on her home, according to Dr. Cantor. The mother cannot work outside of the home since she takes care of her son.

Dr. Cantor encountered Alex about six years ago when the dentist was doing pro bono work for Easterseals as its dental director. That program closed in June of 2015 as the state budget impasse shut down grant funds for the program.

To help the family, Dr. Cantor and Dr. Mrozek decided to create a GoFundMe account to help Alex and his mother.

The page at https://www.gofundme.com/alexs-dental-fund was created Feb. 16 and has a goal of \$17,500 with \$5,000 to fund Alex's general anesthesia dental work, \$2,500 for his mother's dental work and \$10,000 to help the two with living expenses until they can find affordable housing.

As of Monday, March 6, the fund had raised \$4,098, which is \$902 shy of what is needed to schedule Alex's dental care.



Dental therapists clarification

I would like to clarify an answer I gave in response to a question asked of me in a O&A article in the January/February 2017 issue of the CDS Review. The question asked about the incorporation of dental therapists. At a time when a person in this position is asked to do many interviews in every medium, ideas can get misconstrued and in this particular case, my thoughts did not translate correctly to the printed page.

I DO NOT support the addition of another provider to the dental workforce in the form of a dental therapist. This is a concept we in Illinois have been working against for many years. I DO support the expansion of duties of our current workforce by the use of an Expanded Function Dental Assistant (EFDA) to improve access to care within our state. This improvement has been in front of our state House of Delegates many times over the years and gained approval this past fall; the change to our Illinois Dental Practice Act has now been brought to the legislature.

I don't believe that the use of an EFDA in metropolitan Chicago will be widespread because of the large number of dentists available to treat the population. However, in more rural areas in Illinois, where the dentist population is low and there is a great demand for services, an EFDA will be a valuable addition to handle the access to care concerns.

In voting to accept this improvement, I personally had two requirements: That the candidates desiring this designation go through a thorough educational process to master the complicated skills this change would allow, and that the current workforce model be protected so that dentists who didn't want to incorporate this new designation didn't have to.

Leadership Challenge No. 2

N OUR PRVIOUS ISSUE, EDITOR WALTER LAMACKI ASKED ME SOME QUESTIONS FOR A Q&A FEATURE THAT WERE MEANT AS A WAY, I GUESS, FOR MEMBERS TO GET TO KNOW ME.

One of the questions I was asked was how do I balance my volunteer life with my professional and family life? In considering an answer, I thought of what I had heard early in my career from L.D. Pankey – founder of The Pankey Institute – during the first continuum I attended to further my knowledge in treating the whole person.

The symbol adopted by The Institute as its trademark is called

The Cross of Life, with the arms representing love, work, faith and play. Dr. Pankey stressed the importance of keeping your cross in balance, but that balance was subjective and didn't mean that each arm needed to be equal in length.

Volunteerism can play a dominant role in one's life, as long as the other "arms of your cross" don't suffer in expense. I believe as a leader that I am called to give of myself generously. One of my driving forces is a quote paraphrased from the Book of Luke in The Bible, "to whom much is given, much is expected."

We are a blessed society and I consider it my responsibility to help others, where the only reward is the personal satisfaction of doing it coupled with, but not dependent on, a heartfelt thank-you from a life you have impacted.

In 2000, the world lost a wonderful little boy named Jeff Pride. The Prides are next door neighbors and close friends of ours; their son, Jeff, lost a two-year battle with acute lymphoblastic leukemia. Jan and I were able to hold Jeff just after he was born and seconds after he took his last breath. We experienced his battle nearly firsthand and vowed to do whatever it took, so

that some day, no other child would die from cancer and no other family would have to endure what the Prides went through.

Since forming The Jeffrey Pride Foundation for Pediatric Cancer Research, we have spent thousands of hours of personal time working to raise more than \$2.5 million dollars in 15 years. It has been an honor giving of myself to such a worthy cause, with the hope that some day, someone will benefit from our work.

Back in the late 1990s, I was asked by a patient – the director of community outreach for Northwest Community Hospital – if I felt there was a need for a free dental clinic in our area to treat the underserved. After answering with an emphatic "yes," he asked if

I would volunteer to help get such a program started.

We utilized a mobile clinic that would park at designated locations to serve people that could only travel a short distance – us coming to them. After several years of meetings planning, developing, coordinating, interviewing and training, the program was launched. Now, after nearly 14 years, the program is going strong, providing a dental home for thousands of low income/no income families in the northwest suburban area. We recently celebrated the dedication of our second generation, state-of-the-art mobile dental

clinic, having to retire the original one. Not only do I contribute by doing dentistry in the clinic, I have been the chair of the committee that now oversees the program.

Throughout my career I have given back to organized dentistry - giving back to a profession that has been so good to me. While still in dental school, my father - a life member in CDS - invited me to my first branch meeting. He told me that night to get involved in organized dentistry, that I would meet some of the highest quality people while working to sustain our society and protect our profession.

I share these examples not to be braggadocious; please forgive me if that is the way it sounds. I simply want to highlight what is possible in all of us.

So here's my Leadership Challenge to you: Spread your leadership wings and

get involved.

Volunteer at the Midwinter Meeting, where you can help attendees and others in our profession get the most out of their experience. There are nearly 1,000 volunteer positions during the meeting. Join a committee in organized dentistry to share your knowledge and shape the future of our society. There are three levels to choose from, locally within CDS, at the state level through Illinois State Dental Society, or at the national level within the American Dental Association.

Donate your services by doing dentistry for the underserved in your own office through organizations formed to facilitate that arrangement like Dental Lifeline or Give Kids A Smile.

Take it a step further by donating your services at one of the many clinics designated for that purpose, like our own CDS Foundation clinic in Wheaton. If there are clinics in your area, consider giving more of your time there. Every two years when the Illinois State Dental Society organizes its Mission of Mercy, volunteer and be part of that life-changing experience.

And by all means, give of your time outside our field. There are dozens of service clubs, countless foundations and many charitable causes that would love a fresh spirit attached to capable, willing

2017 CDS MIDWINTER MEETING PUTS FOCUS ON LEADERSHIP

N KEEPING WITH THE 2017 MIDWINTER MEETING THEME OF LEADERSHIP: CORNERSTONE FOR SUCCESS, CHICAGO DENTAL SOCIETY PRESIDENT PHILLIP FIJAL SAT DOWN DURING THE OPENING SESSION to discuss leadership with one of the most successful leaders in Chicago sports history, John McDonough, President and CEO of the Chicago Blackhawks.

Mr. McDonough is the driving force behind what Forbes Magazine has called "the



Greatest Sports-Business Turnaround Ever." He has been instrumental in bringing marquee events to Chicago, including the 2009 NHL Winter Classic at Wrigley Field, a Stadium Series game at Soldier Field, and the annual Blackhawks Convention, the first of its kind in the National Hockey League. His migration in 2007 from the Chicago Cubs, where he spent 24 years, to the Chicago Blackhawks exemplifies his extraordinary sense of leadership.

Mr. McDonough was introduced by this year's meeting's General Chair, Jamie Robinson.

"It doesn't always work this way, but when we planned this I didn't anticipate that we would win seven out of eight, the water is warm, things feel good and the Blackhawks are rolling," Mr. McDonough said. The Blackhawks would go on to win later that evening to

take eight out of nine.


Success in the sports arena is not easy, Mr. McDonough pointed out in his introductory remarks.

"You never know what you are going to get at the start of the season," he said. "We've been very, very fortunate winning three Stanley Cups, going to the Western Conference Finals five times, selling out 404 games in a row and leading the NHL in attendance eight seasons in a row, but every single season is different."

Mr. McDonough said he was asked to talk about some of the tenets of leadership—what distinguishes someone as a good leader who can take a business or an organization to another level.

"No. 1, a good leader leads with humility," he said. "Some people would say in our business you've got to have a bit of a swagger, but if you do, it better be humble because this game can bring you to your knees pretty quickly.

"A good leader has a plan," he added. "You have to have continuity, you have to have a plan."

CHRISTENSEN AWARD

The 2017 Gordon J. Christensen Lecturer Recognition Award was presented to K. William "Buddy" Mopper on Feb. 23.

The award was established in 1990 to acknowledge a person who has made many outstanding contributions to the dental profession and the Midwinter Meeting.

Dr. Christensen and CDS President Phillip Fijal made the presentation to Dr. Mopper at the conclusion of one of Dr. Mopper's courses at the Midwinter Meeting.

"Buddy has been a shining light in the

area of conservative dentistry and he has international awards for that," Dr. Christensen told the crowd. "He has been so creative. There is nobody who deserves this award more than Buddy Mopper because he is the one who has tried to help us conserve teeth and not just rip them out.

"Every tooth that is partially destroyed doesn't mean an implant, when we can save the natural tooth we are 10 times better off. Natural teeth are still God's gift and Buddy has been the pioneer in this area."

"I must tell you that I am standing here with the icon of dentistry," Dr. Mopper said of Dr. Chistensen in accepting the award. "I am very honored to be in the presence of this man and am especially honored to be given this award. I can't tell you how much this means to me."

Dr. Mopper is a clinician, educator and businessman. He is an internationally renowned lecturer in aesthetic dentistry with an emphasis on composite bonding using direct application techniques. He is a Fellow of the AAED, founding member and Accredited Fellow of the AACD as well as a Fellow of the American College of Dentistry and the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry.

CUSHING AWARD

The George Cushing Award for 2017 was presented to Thomas Sullivan.

The Cushing Award recognizes those who raise public awareness about the importance of oral health. The CDS Communications Committee recommends the award winner. Dr. Sullivan was announced as the winner during the Opening Session on Feb. 23, with the award being presented by Ingrid Schroetter, the 2017 Chair of the Communications Committee.

"Today we have the honor of bestowing the award to Tom Sullivan for his dedication and commitment to the dental profession by his exemplary work with the CURE Network events," Dr. Schroetter said. "The CURE Network, which stands for Collaborative Underserved Relief and Education, was created to meet the vital and ever-growing need to bring free medical services to the underinsured and those without insurance in the greater Chicagoland area."

In accepting the award, Dr. Sullivan recounted the start of the CDS Foundation Clinic in suburban Wheaton, saying it is a great way for dentists to give back to the community.

Giving back, he said, is important.

"We are a passionate and a blessed profession; men and women who by the grace of our creator are given a gift, a gift to heal, a gift to eliminate pain and suffering, a gift to restore the spirit inside by creating a smile. So I challenge all of you to never, ever, take that gift for granted and some time in your professional career, pass it on. It is in giving that we receive, and it is in healing that we are healed. Thank you so much for this award, and God bless you," Dr. Sullivan said.

In addition to his work with The CURE Network Dr. Sullivan is a past president of the Illinois State Dental Society, as well as a former vice-president of the American Dental Association and a regular volunteer with Mission of Mercy events.

The annual award is named for George Cushing, a prominent Chicago dentist in the mid- to late-1800s and a strong advocate for dental health education. He was a respected author of patient education materials, served as CDS president several times and was an early advocate of preventive dentistry.

CDS FOUNDATION VISION AWARD

The CDS Foundation Vision Award for 2017 was presented to Flavia Lamberghini Feb. 23 at the Opening Session.

The award is given in recognition of outstanding volunteer achievement for being a dedicated philanthropist and volunteer who generously supports access to care programs and dental education for the underserved in the community.

"I'm very honored and touched to be here," Dr. Lamberghini said, as she started to tear up while standing next to her two children, Sofia and Martin.

"I'm sorry... but my tears of joy. . . thanks for this award, it means the world to me to be recognized by my peers. which I think is the highest honor in our profession. I want to say thank you to the Chicago Dental Society and to my mentor Dr. Ron Testa, who nominated me."

She also shared a saying from her childhood.

"Life is service and service is showing, and that's what our profession allows us to do, to serve and be kind and enjoy, so thanks for this honor," she said.

Dr. Lamberghini is a clinical assistant professor at the University of Illinois at Chicago College of Dentistry, Pediatric Dentistry Postgraduate Program.

She also directs Apple Dental Care, a pediatric dental clinic in the Logan Square

Dr. Lamberghini, besides her clinical work and teaching, together with her team also provides preventative dental care to students of more than 60 Chicago schools across the city.

Robin Gathman, CDS Foundation communications chair, introduced Dr. Lamberghini and described some of the volunteer work that she does that led to the award.

"This year's recipient serves many groups, but as a pediatric dentist she serves children who need a dental home that might not otherwise have one," she said. "Every year she gets involved in more than 20 health fairs and community dental education activities across the city of Chicago to raise awareness and promote oral health."

He also said good leaders "distribute all of the praise and absorb all the blame. That's what our role is."

Good leaders also have a decisionmaking system so that there are no kneejerk reactions: "We think it through, but we try to come up with a collaborative and collective answer that is in the best interest of the organization.

"A good leader understands that once you stop to admire your achievements, you've stopped, and it's awfully hard to start again."

"A good leader is interesting and interested. Good leaders are well-read and informed and are truly interested in the people they encounter. You don't learn anything while you're speaking, so be a good listener," he advised.

Other keys to good leadership, according to Mr. McDonough, are to hire the "right people" to join your team, understand the importance of a compliment, and be ready to make unpopular decisions.

"A good leader understands that once you stop to admire your achievements, you've stopped, and it's awfully hard to start again. My role in the success of the Chicago Blackhawks - I would term it as micro-fractional. I have played a small role. You hire really good people, you make sure they understand what your expectations are, and then you do the hardest thing that you have ever done in your career: You step back and you allow them to do their jobs."

Dr. Fijal asked him what communication style and approach he uses to lead his management team at the Blackhawks.

"I probably would say that my management style is comfortably uncomfortable," Mr. McDonough answered. "I want people to be in an environment that's nurturing, where it's innovating, where it's creative, where they're never satisfied, yet at the same time they recognize that there are expectations that come with that."







He said he likes to spend time with all aspects of the organization. As for communications, he said the hockey part and business parts are "melded as one." For instance, the business side is aware of player moves being contemplated, and the hockey operations are aware of ticket prices, television revenue and other business side details. Although open communication is important, Mr. McDonough stressed that it's the general manager and assistant general manager who spend the most time with the team.

"I'm going on my 10th season with the Chicago Blackhawks, and other than the three times when we were fortunate to win the Stanley Cup—one in Philadelphia, one in Boston and one here in Chicago – I have never been in the locker room. I have never addressed the players after a game, and I have never gone into the coach's office after a game," he explained.

He said the coach knows he is responsible for the players and the team on the ice, and the general manager is responsible for putting the team together with collaboration with that coach, but if he, as the president and CEO, would go into the locker room or have a relationship with the players, it could be awkward because he wants to make sure the message is consistent through the general manager and the head coach.

He pointed to the late Chicago Bears General Manager Jim Finks, who also worked for the Cubs and hired McDonough, as one of his leadership mentors.

"I just loved his style, his grace with people," Mr. McDonough said. "He was more of a big picture guy."

It is important for those under you to know they have your support, Mr. McDonough added. "I want everyone in our organization to succeed, I want to give them every tool possible for them to succeed. So whether it is in the face of a four- or five-game losing streak, or whether we have won seven out of eight, I want them to understand that the guy at the top wants them to succeed, and if they are going through a rough time they need you more than ever."








FASHION SHOW








ROBERT UNGER HONORED










































JOIN US IN 2018

"We have planned and implemented several new ideas including a bootcamp



"Midwinter is more like an event than a meeting," he exclaimed.



HE 152ND MIDWINTER MEETING HAD EVERYBODY TALKING ABOUT LEADERSHIP, not only the good and the bad, but how we might best cultivate great leaders for the future.

It's an important discussion to have in your individual practice of dentistry, too, because you have so many leaders working on the same team. Each person in your office has a role in guiding your patients toward better heath; therefore, each member of your office team has an interest in becoming a better leader.

But their leadership styles are going to be as varied as their personalities. And that's just fine. A round-table discussion of their preferences, strengths and weaknesses as leaders will enable each member of the team to grow professionally.

Consider my pre-writing efforts to concisely define leadership for the purpose of this column. A quick search for the keyword "LEADERSHIP" at my local library revealed 1,198 results on site, peppering most every aisle of the building. I rolled my eyes at the one called *Leadership: A Very Short Introduction* – a mere 142 pages long.

I settled instead upon an even thicker book from the widely respected Norton Anthology series. In *Leadership: Essential Writings by our Greatest Thinkers* (2015), editor Elizabeth Samet calls on most every discipline, culture, and era of world history for input. There are articles from Malcolm Gladwell, Franklin Roosevelt, Machiavelli, Sun Tzu, Gandhi, Shakespeare, Leo Tolstoy, Ovid, Elizabeth I, George Patton, the *Book of Exodus* and a parable from the Gospel according to St. Matthew bound together.

The collection offers something for every taste, and in the in-

troduction, Ms. Samet writes, ". . . the work of understanding, analyzing, interpreting, comparing, contrasting, synthesizing and reflecting – the work that serious literature compels a reader to perform – can help awaken leaders and keep them ever sharp."

It was, therefore, in the interest of brevity that I asked my social media friends to consider their best bosses and what made them great leaders. Their responses were as varied as the library resources that had overwhelmed me, but my friends agreed that good leaders don't have to have all the answers. Great leaders surround themselves with talented people and welcome their input.

"My best bosses all had something in common: When they had no good ideas, they stayed out of the way of the people who did," explained a veteran journalist.

"My best boss let me come to him when I was unsure, without making me feel foolish," said a communications consultant. "He praised me when it was due and helped me with my challenges."

Added a social worker, "I trusted her. I could talk freely without fear of judgment and would get guidance. I never left her office without more clarity. A leader first, friend second."

And a 30-something engineering executive summed it up beautifully: "I think what's always made the best bosses is when they can really identify what you are good at – like, what you really are talented at – and find ways to use that in the organization. Also, I've found the best leaders listen; they don't always have to have the answers, but they help other people figure out what they are thinking and feeling in a structured, organized way. The best bosses are the ones who push you and are honest about your shortcomings because that is how you grow."

Getting assistance

ENTAL ASSISTANTS ARE VALUABLE PARTNERS IN PROVIDING GOOD DENTAL CARE TO OUR PATIENTS. And as a dentist knows, a good dental assistant can make practicing dentistry less stressful and more rewarding. For example, taking dental X-rays and documenting any changes to a patient's medical history are vital functions performed by dental assistants. However, the dental professional must be knowledgeable about the specific duties an assistant can or cannot perform as defined by the *Illinois Dental Practice Act*. Moreover, a dentist may be liable, both in civil lawsuits and in dental board matters, for the negligent action or improper conduct by a dental assistant.

In Illinois, a dental assistant is not required to take a formal training program or be certified. Certification is earned by completing a dental assistant program, of which there are many in Illinois.

However, a dental assistant, in order to perform "expanded functions" – such as coronal polishing under the supervision of a licensed dentist – must meet stringent state requirements as set forth in the Dental Practice Act. For instance, non-certified dental assistants can perform functions such as fabricating and temporarily cementing provisional crowns.

However, in order for a dental assistant to perform expanded functions, some of which are monitoring nitrous oxide patients or placing pit and fissure sealants, the assistant must successfully complete a training program, log many hours of clinical

experience and have a basic life support certification for nitrous or sedation monitoring. Additionally, dental assistants are not permitted to perform certain procedures that include taking final impressions for permanent crowns or bridges or permanently cementing or re-cementing permanent restorations.

I recommend that dentists visit the Dental Assistant National Board website (www.danb.org), which nicely lays out what functions a dental assistant can perform, along with the training requirements for expanded functions. It is crucial for the dentist to train and monitor the dental assistant on issues pertaining to patient confidentiality

A dental assistant is permitted to make entries in the dental records. To that end, a dentist must show the assistant what information gets entered into the chart. An assistant, for instance, must not document derogatory comments about a difficult patient.

An assistant (in the privacy of the operatory) may go over any changes to the medical history and current medications. It is important that the dental assistant understands that this information must be accurately recorded, as it can have an impact on dental care.

While dental assistants are indispensable members of the dental team, the dentist must ensure that they are properly trained and are made aware of the functions they can perform within the law and within their clinical experience.



ORE THAN 970 STUDENTS AT CHICAGO'S NATHAN HALE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL gathered for assemblies Jan. 13 that were presented by health officials to teach the children how important it is for them to maintain good dental health in order to do well in school.

Ald. Marty Quinn (13th Ward) served as master-of-ceremonies for the assemblies, introducing a number of health care dignitaries to the attentive and respectful crowd of students.

Illinois State Dental Society Director of Government Relations Dave Marsh presented Hale Assistant Principal Brian Yracheta with a \$1,000 check to help

fund the school's dental health efforts. Chicago Dental Society member Loren Feldner was also on hand to help distribute goodie bags of toothbrushes and toothpaste to the students, donated by CDS.

Kenneth Fox, Chicago Public Schools chief health officer, and Julie Morita, commissioner of the Chicago Department of Public Health – who are both pediatricians – spoke with the children about the importance of keeping good dental hygiene including brushing their teeth three times a day, flossing daily and eating a healthy diet that includes fruits and vegetables; and avoiding sugar-laden treats such as soda and sports drinks.

Strong teeth are needed to properly chew food, speak correctly and have a nice healthy smile, Dr. Morita told the students. She also reminded them that they should drink plenty of water.

The assemblies were part of a day of dental health gatherings for the entire student body. Students were also offered the opportunity for screenings and cleanings though the office of Peter Contos.

Sahar Alrayyes goes a long distance to bring care to special

needs children

S A PEDIATRIC DENTIST AND FESSOR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ILLINOIS AT CHICAGO COLLEGE OF DENTISTRY, SAHAR ALRAYYES TEACHES OTHER DENTISTS HOW TO TREAT CHILDREN. But when she makes one of her numerous mission trips to the Middle East, she also teaches parents and children with special needs how to do preventative care.

Dr. Alrayyes said there is a push to teach the families of children with special needs the importance of good dental hygiene including brushing, flossing and avoiding foods such as sugary treats that can have a detrimental effect on a child's dental heath. And nothing gives Dr. Alrayyes as much pleasure as making a



return trip and hearing from the parents that they are following her advice.

"It is music to my ears," Dr. Alrayyes said.

She has had plenty of opportunities to get such great feedback.

Working with the Palestine Children's Relief Fund, she has provided service in Jordan, Syria, Iraq and Lebanon as well as in the Palestinian territory of the West Bank. She was scheduled to travel to Gaza at the end of March, having returned late last year from her fourth trip to Bethlehem.

"I've been committed to treating special needs children for sometime," Dr. Alrayyes explained. "I received a grant from the ADA on how to treat children with autism."

On her trips, she trains dental students as well as general dentists.

"The perception is that they (special needs children) are hard patients to treat, but I am trying to break the stigma that they can't be treated in the dental chair," Dr. Alrayyes said.

"Any dental provider can do an exam or even restoration work as well" on children with special needs, she added.

She said word of mouth is the best way for dentists in the West Bank area to know that there are resources available when she visits.

Besides the West Bank, Dr. Alrayyes has also done missions and provided services.

She usually spends a week at a time when traveling, staying at a hotel near where she will be working.

The first day of her mission is typi-



cally spent screening the children on a list of patients and determining what needs are to be done, and setting up a schedule for the work. Dr. Alrayyes said she treats 30 to 50 patients during her week in an area, with much of the work entailing full mouth rehabilitation, which, at times, requires the patient to be under general anesthesia.

She said the issue of poor dental hygiene for special needs children is "not so much cultural," but rooted in the fact that there is not enough education about proper dental health available.

"They don't go to the dentist unless there is a problem," she said of many of the people she encounters in the Middle East. "If there is pain then they go to the dentist, if there is no pain they don't go."

Yet, she said it has been her experience that families in the West Bank area do see the benefits of seeing a dentist and getting care.

"These parents would travel two to three hours on public transportation just to get where we are," she said of the effort many families take to get care when it is available.

Besides the professional gratification associated with the trips, Dr. Alrayyes said she also enjoys other aspects of traveling in an area that has deep historical significance for many cultures.

"I like the simplicity," she said. "People ask me if I feel safe. I feel more safe there than walking the street at night in Chicago."

Dr. Alrayyes said she is in awe of the ancient structures that have survived for centuries as well as the eclectic cuisine that can nourish the soul and the body.

"There is a real history (to the West Bank) especially with all of the interfaith aspects, it is nice to see all these sites, how old they are and what complexity there is. It is interesting to see how big these sites are and how they were built all those years ago," Dr. Alrayyes said.

But she finds helping people the most rewarding part of her trips, she emphasized.

"The people are so nice, the food there is good, but what makes you feel really good is that you could serve the underserved." ■







Confronting difficult choices

ental Medicaid in Illinois is in shambles, caused in part by our state government's malfeasance and the lack of a state budget.

Our elected officials are oblivious to the needs of the public they are sworn to serve. Reimbursement rates for dental Medicaid allowable procedures have not risen from the piteous levels of 1997 - the lowest in the United States. Add a bureaucracy mired in molasses, caressing rules and regulations, but tonedeaf to outcomes, and you have the first act of a Franz Kafka play. It's no wonder that few Illinois dentists (approximately 1,700) are Medicaid providers. Not long ago there were 2,800 dentists involved with Medicaid.

I recently received a letter from a respected colleague that encapsulates the financial landmine Medicaid dentists must navigate. He owns two practices - one a traditional practice and the other a Medicaid practice focused on treating children. In his traditional practice, my colleague has the power to raise fees as the costs to do business increase, and there is less paperwork; in essence he has control of his practice, which doesn't happen in a Medicaid practice.

In his letter, he wrote that he met with the staff of his Medicaid practice to brainstorm to find cost-saving strategies for dental procedures and out-of-control administrative costs. The low fees and burgeoning red tape of the Medicaid system made him question how he can meet the federal mandate to provide dental care for children.

His staff meeting took place after the Illinois State Dental Society's House of Delegates adopted a resolution to allow suitably trained dental assistants to perform supra-gingival scaling on

children under the age of 12. The potential hiring of this new auxiliary was discussed at the meeting as a practical addition to the staff to contain costs. The practice already employs dental assistants qualified to polish teeth for children up to 12 years of age, but not to scale. After the meeting adjourned, he asked, as he always does, if his staff had any thoughts.

Yikes! He got more than he anticipated in a letter from one of his dearest friends and his hygienist of 20 years.

In her letter, she complained that the practice's assistants were not, in her opinion, doing an acceptable job of polishing and needed more supervision. She took it upon herself to try to retrain them. She went on to say that any child older than 3 needed to be scaled. "And now you're going to allow assistants to pick up a scaler and expand their functions? I understand the (financial) realities of a Medicaid practice, but people are people."

She ended her letter stating: "I have always believed if you do the right thing, things will work out."

The dentist took her comments to heart. He wrote, "... my hygienist's words struck me hard and guided me back to my core values of integrity and respect. I decided to add a hygienist to the practice in order to ensure that the patients were getting the proper care."

Often we are confronted by a choice between our own self interest and a sacrifice for the greater good.

We all know that raising dental Medicaid fees to a reasonable level would go a long way in our fight to increase access to dental care for our underserved population. Hello legislature, are you listening? ■
