Use personal touch approach when addressing patient complaints

THE PANDEMIC HAS EVERYONE ON THE EDGE.

Dental offices are fielding more complaints than ever from disgruntled or anxious patients.

What do you do when Mrs. Smith emails that her bill is too high or when Mr. Jones calls to complain about an uncomfortable new crown on Tooth #19?

The first thing to do in both instances is to take a breath; a knee jerk reaction may only make the problem worse. In Mrs. Smith's case, she has emailed your office manager complaining about the amount of her bill for four composite restorations. What's the best way to handle this?

While acknowledging that many office managers are excellent in dealing with such comments, the dentist should consider contacting Mrs. Smith by phone to discuss her dissatisfaction. There is simply no substitute for the dentist personally addressing such an issue.

As I have said in a previous column, "Pick up the phone, not the mouse." Speaking to the patient is the better way to address a patient complaint.

But before picking up the phone, the dentist should review the chart and make written notes so you are prepared to inform

Mrs. Smith that your fees for your dental work are the same fees you charge all your patients.

You should resist ignoring her or writing a snarky email response. And make sure you are prepared to handle the call before making the call.

Regarding Mr. Jones' complaint, you must resist the temptation to be short with him. Rather, take some time in a quiet place in your office to review his chart and make some notes regarding what you will say in order to reassure him that you care and are happy to see him.

It is wise to avoid telling him to "tough it out" or immediately referring for a root canal.

It's a good policy to put yourself in the patient's shoes.

For example, after recently having had a root canal, I have a better perspective how my own patient might feel being on the receiving end of local anesthetic, a rubber dam and post-treatment discomfort.

It is easy for a dentist in these hectic days to make quick, rash responses to certain patient complaints. However, taking a breath and thinking it through not only avoids escalating a situation and turning it into a lawsuit or board complaint, it is also a great practice builder.

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Volunteer Spotlight: Margaret Buell

THIS COLUMN IS DEDICATED TO THE MANY GENEROUS VOLUNTEERS who help the CDS Foundation provide access to care and dental education to residents of communities within the Chicago Dental Society district.

Today we shine a spotlight on Margaret Buell, who practices in Skokie, and volunteers regularly at the CDS Foundation Clinic in Wheaton.

Why did you get involved at the clinic and how has the experience changed you?

“I had a hand injury and some other health issues, and was out of practice for a while. Working at the CDS Foundation clinic has helped me get back on my feet, bolster my confidence level, and learn from other dentists I’ve met there. The clinic helps dentists as well as patients.”

What motivates you to donate your time to patients at the clinic?

“I’ve always had a preference for public health dentistry. Oftentimes, at the CDS Foundation Clinic and other public health settings, the goal is to control disease processes, stabilize the patient’s dentition during a transient rough patch (period of unemployment, etc.), and preserve future treatment options.

“This usually involves weighing many facets of the patient’s overall clinical pic-



ture to come up with a comprehensive treatment approach, and possibly staging treatment in the event that the patient’s circumstances change. For example, sometimes we will stabilize a retained root, instead of extracting it, and design a denture around it with the goal of preserving the bone surrounding the root in case the patient can afford an implant in the future.

“Working in public health sometimes requires going beyond dentistry and en-

gaging with primary care, pediatrics, social work and other disciplines, which really makes dentistry feel like part of the larger healthcare delivery system.”

What do you do when you are not volunteering or working?

“I read and try to figure out what I want to do next in my career. I am considering a Master of Public Health, among other things.”

What is a fun fact about you?

“I collect vintage silver-plated flatware and sometimes polish it with toothpaste. Crest with Scope works really well.”

What do you wish other people knew about the CDS Foundation?

“That we provide a valuable service for the community, which ranges from making esthetic improvements in a patient’s smile to restoring chewing function to treating severe infection and pain.”

As a volunteer, what sort of trends do you see?

“I have seen several cases of rampant decay, often around existing restorations. In collaboration with Dr. Tish Nihill, who teaches at Midwestern University, we have implemented silver diamine fluoride as a way to temporarily arrest decay while we restore the teeth, which can be a long and extensive process if many teeth need treatment.”

Why do you continue to volunteer?

“One of the great things about the CDS Foundation Clinic is the ability to collaborate with other dentists and dental specialists. This is great for me since I’m still early into my career and appreciate mentorship from the experienced dentists I’ve been lucky to meet on my volunteer days. Sometimes working by myself in practice can feel very isolating, so it’s nice to be able to say to another dentist colleague, ‘Hey, doc, what do you think about this?’ The collaborative environment definitely keeps me coming back.” ■

Dental community reconnects in Chicago for the 2022 Midwinter Meeting

TRADITION RETURNED TO McCORMICK PLACE WEST as the Chicago Dental Society's Midwinter Meeting once again filled the Exhibit Hall and classrooms with dental professionals from around the country and around the world.

The words heard most often during the 157th Midwinter Meeting, *A Dental Tradition*, were "it's good to be back." It was the first in-person gathering for the annual event since 2020. The Covid-19 pandemic forced the meeting to be held as a virtual event in 2021.

2022 CDS President Thomas Schneider Jr. welcomed attendees Thursday morning as he cut the ribbon opening the Exhibit Hall floor to a waiting and eager crowd. Almost 450 exhibitors filled the hall showcasing the latest in dental technology, equipment and services.

"I could not be happier with the success of the 157th Midwinter Meeting," Dr. Schneider said later. "After the pandemic kept us apart, it was amazing to be back together in person. The opportunity to spend time and reconnect with my friends and colleagues was wonderful."

A return to an in-person meeting also meant a return of popular social events that give attendees a chance to socialize while enjoying food and beverages. Several of the events are geared toward the younger crowd, including early ca-

reer dentists and dental students.

"The mentors luncheon, New Dentist Reception and the Dental Student Reception were some of my favorite events," Dr. Schneider said of those gatherings. "Interacting in-person with the young professionals in dentistry was so inspiring. I am excited about the future of the Chicago Dental Society and our profession."

Dr. Schneider and his team of General Chair Michelle Jennings and Program Chair Mary Starsiak were on hand for many of the events, welcoming attendees back and enjoying the camaraderie that was missed.

Keynote Session & Awards

In place of the Opening Session that historically had capped off the first day of the meeting, the Keynote Session offered a glimpse into the history of dentistry, including the emergence of Chicago as a hub for dental education.

General Chair Michelle Jennings acted as emcee and welcomed attendees to the Keynote Session and said this year's meeting theme, as selected by 2022 CDS President Thomas Schneider Jr., is "A *Dental Tradition*," which signifies his family's long history of dedication and service to the dentistry profession.

Along with recognizing Dr. Schneider, Dr. Jennings also recognized this year's Program Chair, Mary Starsiak, who later introduced speaker Scott D. Swank, DDS, curator of the Dr. Samuel D. Harris National Museum of Dentistry at the University of Maryland in Baltimore.

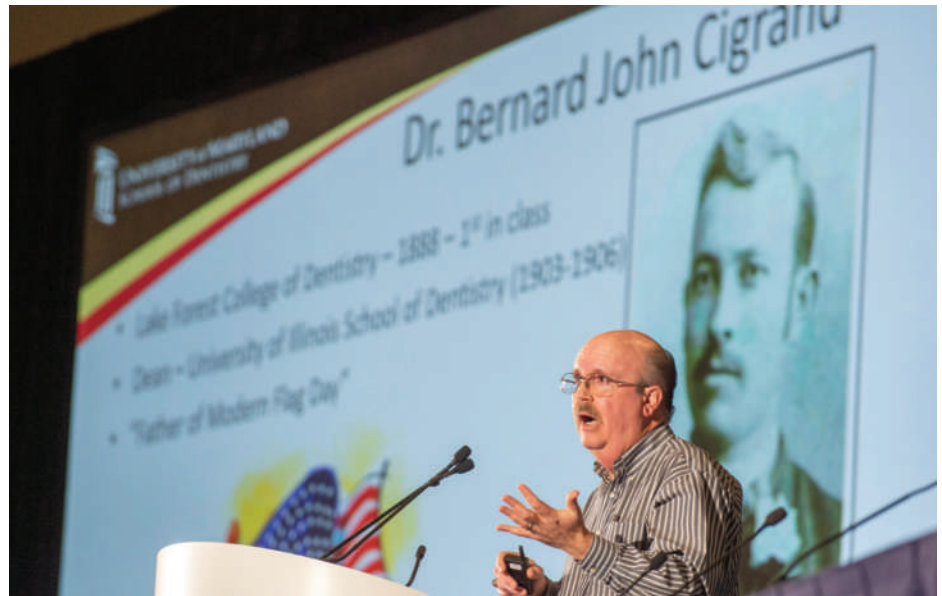
Dr. Swank told the assembled group that even before dentistry was a recognized profession in the modern sense, humans used rudimentary instruments and materials to relieve pain and fix dental problems.

He said knowing the history of dentistry gives dental professionals a perspective of where they fit.

"I like to start at what I think is the beginning, and what is the beginning is history: humans have suffered from oral health problems forever."

He showed a photo of a fossilized tooth that dated from 50,000 to 12,000 years ago that showed an endodontic opening.

"Somebody had an oral health problem, a toothache, and somebody else took a flint tool of some kind and burrowed into this tooth until they finally got to the pulp chamber. It was probably necrotic and built up pressure – thus the pain – and you drill into it, the pus comes out and the pressure is relieved and the per-



son is out of pain – at least for a little while," Dr. Swank said.

That ancient effort didn't include a record of who did the drilling, but Dr. Swank said the earliest record of a person recognized as a dentist comes from the Egyptians with hieroglyphs showing someone being identified as a dentist through the use of a symbol of a tusk and an awl. A falcon included in the group means he was the most skilled and was probably the dentist to the pharaoh at the time during the first dynasty of the old kingdom, which predated the Great Pyramids.

There is also evidence of dental bridges being used in ancient Egypt using gold wire, and in what is now Italy during the Etruscan era – 900 to 27 BC – a bridge that used gold bands.

Think implants are a modern invention? Think again, Dr. Swank said.

He showed a picture of an iron tooth-shaped item that was fitted into the upper jaw of a Roman as a replacement tooth. Mayans also carved tooth replacements out of shells, he said. There are also examples of preventative care in the ancient world. He showed a slide of a bamboo handled

tooth brush with boar bristles that is traced to the Ming Dynasty in China.

Jump ahead a few millennia and the profession of dentistry and organizations that supported its practitioners evolved along with the educational system to teach people dentistry. The Chicago Dental Society was formed in 1864, just a few years after the American Dental Association was established, and soon after, the meeting that grew into the Midwinter Meeting event, one of the largest dental gatherings in the country, was launched.

Formal dental education in the U.S. started in 1840 and in 1864 there was discussion about starting a dental school in Chicago, Dr. Swank said.

Between 1883 (when the first school formed in Chicago) and 1902, 28 dental schools had formed in Chicago. Not all lasted but the first one, established in 1883, eventually became Loyola University School of Dentistry. The school closed in 1993, but for 17 years Dr. William Schoen was its dean. In the spirit of this year's theme of dental tradition, Dr. Swank noted that he was none other than Dr. Schneider's grandfather.

GORDON CHRISTENSEN AWARD

The 2022 Gordon J. Christensen Lecturer Recognition Award recipient is Michael DiTolla of Irvine, CA, a noted educator who is a frequent speaker at the Midwinter Meeting.

The award was established in 1990 and honors a professional whose contributions to further the continuing education of dental professionals. Dr. Christensen presented the award at Friday's Keynote Session.

"What makes you want to listen to a speaker," Dr. Christensen asked the crowd, "in any area of life, a pastor, a politician, an athlete, anybody who is trying to express themselves, what makes that speaker important and influential to you?"

He said there are several qualities that successful speakers must have, including knowledge about the subject matter, being up-to-date with information and having a "real" personality with humor.

In presenting the award to Dr. DiTolla, Dr. Christensen said the recipient had all of those qualities in spades.

Dr. DiTolla returned to private practice in 2021 after serving as director of clinical affairs for what is now Dentsply Sirona



and is renowned for giving entertaining lectures that blend humor and entertainment to engage attendees.

"I love this meeting," Dr. DiTolla said. "There are a lot of great national meetings but there is only one Midwinter Meeting in dentistry. This is our Super Bowl."

Dr. DiTolla noted his long association with Dr. Christensen and said, "As a speaker there is no one I've looked up to more, so honestly this is a dream come true to be able to receive something like this from Gordon."

CDS FOUNDATION VISION AWARD

The 2022 Chicago Dental Society Foundation Vision Award, which honors dedicated volunteers who generously support access to care programs and dental education for the underserved community, was presented by CDS Foundation chair D. Spencer Pope to 2016 CDS President George Zehak.

In 2021, Dr. Zehak added to the dental care in the Elgin area as dental director of the Heal Elgin Clinic, mobilizing senior dental students to provide more than \$170,000 in procedures at no cost to more than 400 individuals in need.

"We do these things not because we want awards," Dr. Zehak said of his volunteerism. "It's a great honor to be considered in the distinguished ranks of past honorees, most of whom are colleagues of mine at one time or another, all of whom have made important contributions to our patients in need."

He said there is nothing more rewarding than being able to give back to those in need.

"Dentistry is such a great profession, and I'm so blessed to be part of it," Dr. Zehak said.

"From giving a person a chance to smile again by taking them out of pain, there are so many patients out there who need our help and we can do it, we can take out time and do that for them."



Dr. Zehak said he gets a tremendous amount of satisfaction helping patients.

He credited the CDS Foundation for helping with the dental needs of local people.

"In reality, helping our patients who are un-served or underserved is just like the award I am receiving, it's wonderful," he said.

Wisconsin Dental Breakfast



The Chicago Dental Society welcomed dental professionals from north of Illinois' border at a special breakfast for Wisconsin Dental Association attendees on the first morning of the meeting.

The Midwinter Meeting has been a popular destination for the Wisconsin dental community for years, especially after the state's association discontinued its meeting.

Wisconsin Dental Association Executive Director Mark Paget said he was "thrilled" with the showing of Wisconsin dental professionals attending this year's Midwinter Meeting, especially considering challenges of the past few years.

"This has been a nice tradition for us,"

Mr. Paget said of heading to Chicago for the Midwinter Meeting "We're so grateful to the Chicago Dental Society for the collaboration. Our members really appreciate this (the breakfast) and it's a nice way for them to start their day and get a little food in their belly and head off to class."

He said working together makes sense for Wisconsin and CDS.

"We promote this meeting and we encourage our members to attend and they just love this event," he said.

The CDS Mentor Program offers an opportunity for pre-dental and dental students to pair with participating CDS dentists and get real-world advice.

He said he usually makes plans to



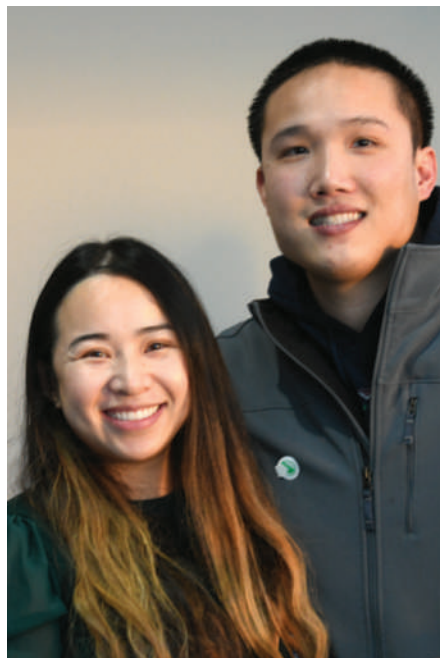
meet with former classmates who are in Chicago for the Midwinter Meeting, and the New Dentist Reception offers the perfect opportunity to do so.

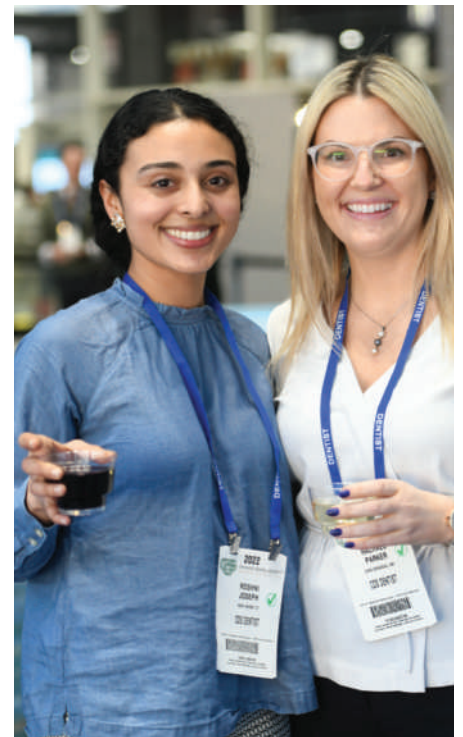

just off the Exhibit Hall floor.

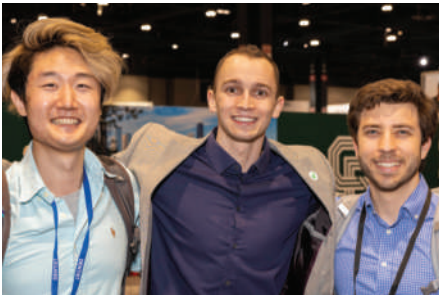
First-year student Shahd Louaiba, who attends the University of Illinois at Chicago College of Dentistry, said she is impressed with the Midwinter Meeting.

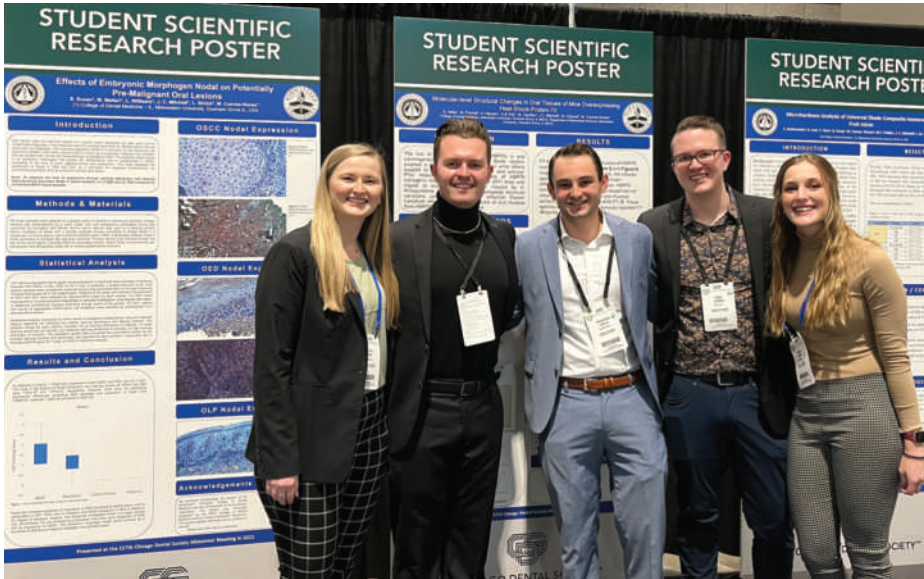

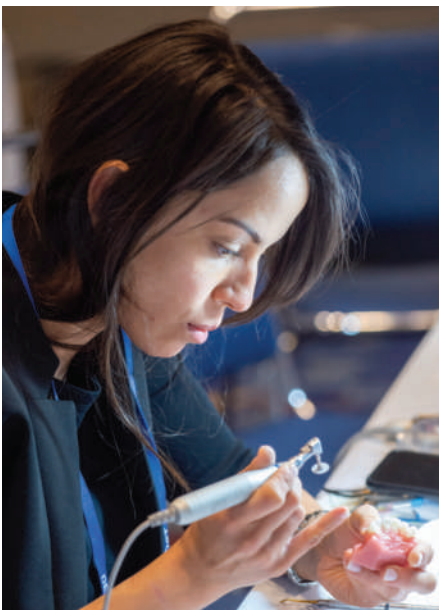

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NORTHWEST SIDE BRANCH CELEBRATES

One Hundred years

The Northwest Side Branch will celebrate its 100-year anniversary with a gala planned for Saturday, April 9, at the Park Ridge Country Club

IT WAS A SIMPLE REQUEST. “Can you send me in the right direction?” Dr. Paul Muhr, correspondent for the Northwest Side Branch wrote to CDS last summer.

“As correspondent,” he wrote, “I was thinking. . . I could write about our first branch president from 1923,” a doctor the record books identified as Olaf Olafsson.

Little did anyone expect that the “history dig” would reveal that Dr. Olafsson (1882-1957) was not the first branch president but instead was Edward G. Faller (1888-1955). More significantly, the branch was founded a year earlier than thought, marking 2022 as the

branch’s centennial anniversary that also coincides with CDS presidency of Dr. Thomas Schneider Jr., a dedicated Northwest Sider.

“The Chicago Dental Society is rich in tradition,” noted Dr. Schneider.

“Our branch membership has a rich history of dental leaders and devoted mentors,” he said. “I could not be more proud that my year as the Chicago Dental Society president coincides with our branch’s centennial celebration.”

Anniversaries come and go, but centennial anniversaries carry a little more “wow”: staying power, historical arc and loyalty. Coincidentally, the branch was

formed in the waning years of the 1918 Spanish flu pandemic. Ring a bell, 100 years later?

Dr. Muhr’s request last year launched a deep dive into the Chicago Dental Society’s bound archives. Volumes of meeting minutes going back to 1920 line several shelves in CDS’ downtown office. Yellowed and musty, the 1922 volume outlines the story of a group of 37 dentists who presented a petition at a general CDS meeting on March 21, 1922, asking to carve out a new branch from the boundaries of the West Side Branch.

"It is suggested the proposed new society be known as the Northwest Branch, or the Logan Square Branch." Among the signatories were Drs. Faller (a 1912 Northwestern University Dental School graduate) and Olafsson (also a Northwestern Dental School alumnus, 1905).

A bylaws amendment was proposed to create seven branches of CDS. On April 18, 1922, when CDS held its annual business meeting for the election of officers, the motion was carried by members. The official boundaries of the branch were formally adopted June 8, 1922. The branch received its first budget from CDS at the start of the fiscal year in January 1923 – \$135.

By October 1922, the Northwest Side Branch was in business, putting on one of its first branch meetings for its membership of approximately 185 dentists.

"Our branch membership has a rich history of dental leaders and devoted mentors."

A Dr. Johnson spoke that evening on "The value of organization."

"The speaker and his subject give every assurance of enjoying a very profitable evening. The subject is well chosen, and timely, inasmuch as this society is in its early development," reported the *CDS Official Bulletin*, the forerunner of the *CDS Review*.

The Northwest Side Branch will celebrate its 100-year anniversary with a gala planned for Saturday, April 9, at the Park Ridge Country Club. Branch members will gather for an evening of food and entertainment to celebrate this once-in-a-century milestone.

Beginnings were modest, but the branch has put down deep roots and inspired dedicated members over its 100 years. Here's to many more.

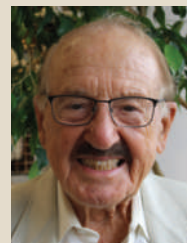
Staying power

There's no one who can say more about staying power and loyalty than Dr. Sam Cascio, a branch member since 1952.

"It's developed into a tight-knit branch," said Dr. Cascio, 97. "It's been my lifeblood." Over his career, he served in all branch offices as well as leadership positions with other dental organizations, and he still attends branch meetings. In fact, he was a Presiding Chair, introducing a speaker, at this year's Midwinter Meeting.

"I think the Northwest Side Branch has done really well, I'm really proud to be a member," said Dr. Cascio, who graduated in 1952 from the Chicago College of Dental Surgery, which later became Loyola University's dental school.

Those Northwest Side roots go even deeper: Dr. Cascio recalls being offered a job by Dr. Schneider's grandfather, Dr. William Schoen, who taught and later was dean of Loyola's Dental School.
