RESERVATIONS

Chicago in Literature Tour



Guests will take a journey through time as they discover Chicago through two new classics in modern literature: The Time Traveler's Wife and The Devil in the White City.

The Time Traveler's Wife by Chicago-based author Audrey Niffenegger is the untraditional love story of Henry DeTamble—a librarian at Chicago's famous Newberry Library who involuntarily travels through time—and Clare Abshire—an artist. Henry and Clare's love affair endures across a sea of time. Tour Guests will see the Newberry Library, The Field Museum, The Civic Opera House, the Art Institute of Chicago, Chicago's Hyde Park neighborhood, and much more.

The Devil in the White City by Erick Larson intertwines the true tale of two men: the brilliant architect Daniel Burnham, who was behind the legendary 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago, and the cunning serial killer, H.H. Holmes, who used the fair to lure his victims to their death.

Through stories of grand plans and sinister plots, this portion of the tour will take guests on a journey to explore many of the sights that fairgoers would have seen in 1893. Guests will see Fredrick Law Olmsted's Wooded Island, Osaka Gardens and the storied Midway Plaisance, and more.
