With nearly 30 years of experience as a practicing periodontist in Chicago, Dr. Thomas Schneider joins the Chicago Dental Society (CDS) Board, and was sworn in as treasurer at a ceremony held on Sunday, November 12, at the Palmer House Hotel.

As treasurer, Dr. Schneider will focus CDS's efforts on membership and attendance at the 153rd Midwinter Meeting, February 22-24, 2018, at the McCormick Place West. The Midwinter Meeting is one of the largest exhibits of dental products and professional dentistry in North America - ranking among Chicago's top 20 conventions, and typically generating more than \$29 million for the local economy (according to Choose Chicago).

CDS was established in 1864, and with more than 4,400 members in Cook, Lake and DuPage counties, is the largest local society of the American Dental Association.

Dr. Schneider graduated from the University of Illinois, Chicago College of Dentistry as well as from the Loyola University Chicago School of Dentistry with a Specialty in Periodontics. In addition to CDS, he is a member of the American Dental Association, Illinois State Dental Society, American Academy of Periodontology, Illinois Society of Periodontists, Midwest Society of Periodontology, The Odontographic Society of Chicago, and is a Fellow of both the International College of Dentists and the American College of Dentists.
